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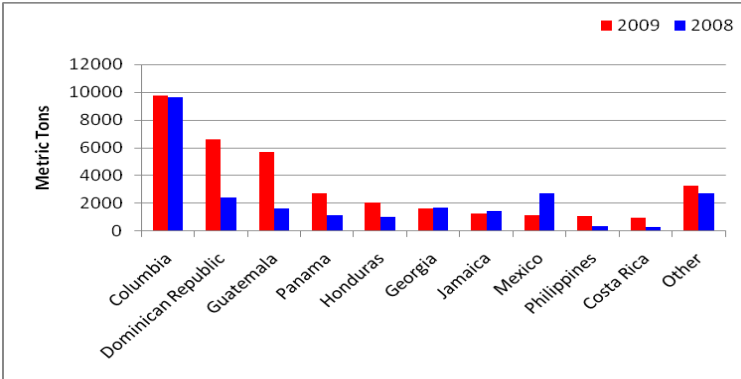

Comparison of Top US Exports of Mechanically Separated Chicken (MSC) by Volume (Metric Tons) from January-September 2009 with 2008



Based on data from the US Department of Commerce, total export volumes of US MSC (HS1602320035) rose 44% in the first 3 quarters of 2009 from 2008 making 2009 levels equal to annual totals of 2008 and years past. Top export destinations continue to be to Colombia and the Dominican Republic as Mexico fell from third to eighth with Guatemala taking third. Annual contract negotiations are underway and mostly concluded in the US seeing reported levels in between those of years past and record 2009 levels.

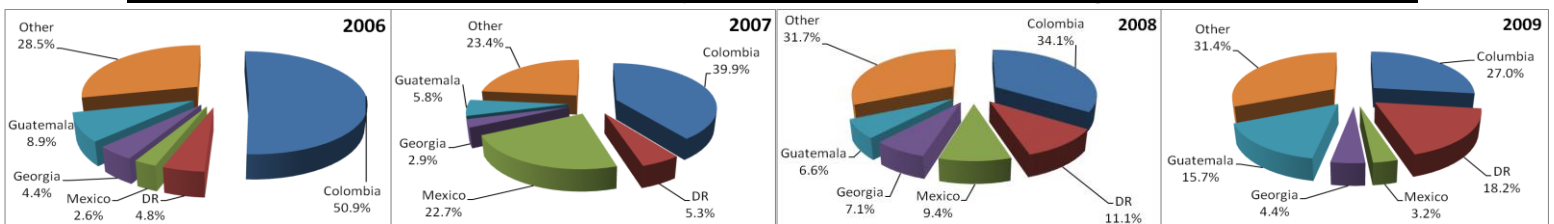

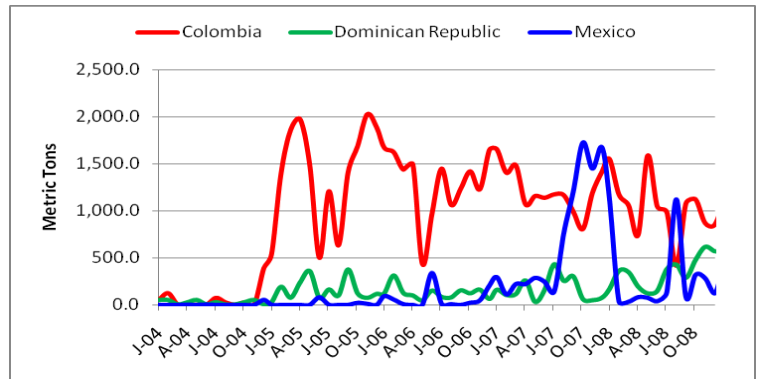
Comparison of Top US Exports of MSC in 2008 by Volume and Destination (Percentage of Total US MSC Exports)



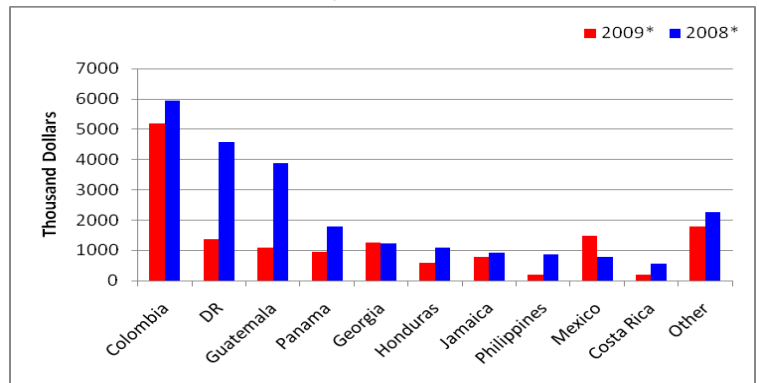

Top US Exports of MSC to Colombia, Dominican Republic, and Mexico in Metric Tons (MT)

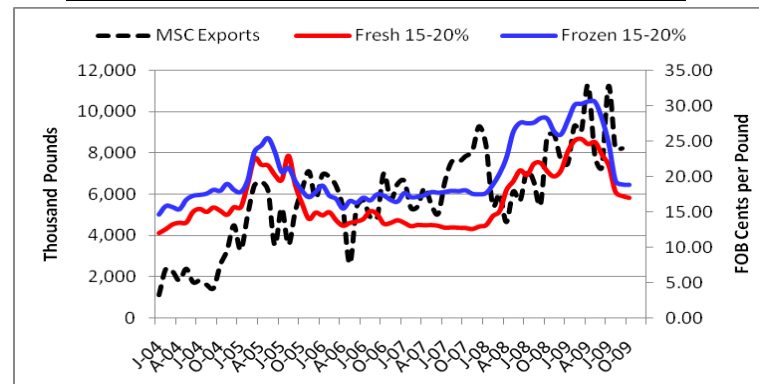


Comparison of Top US Exports of MSC by Value (Thousand Dollars) from January-September 2009 with 2008

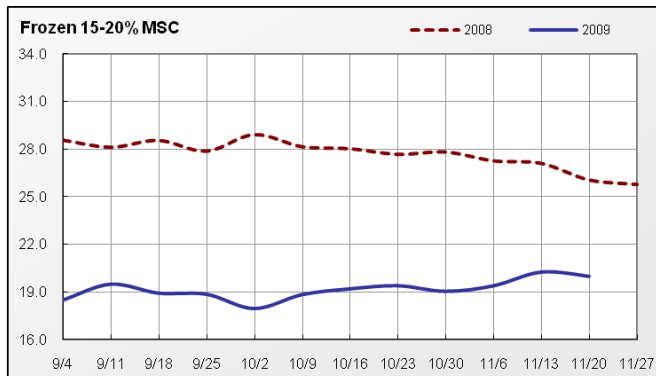
NATIONAL MECHANICALLY SEPARATED CHICKEN

(FOB Shipper Dock or equiv., negotiated prices in trucklot and less-than-trucklot volumes reported in thousand lb. quantities, cents/lb.; delivery within 2 weeks.)

The market tone was steady on all fat contents. Supplies of fresh and frozen 15-20% were adequate to available with the remainder of fat contents adequate to at least adequate. Supplies of raw materials were adequate to available. Many continue closely watching the marketplace as contract negotiations persist with some players still trying to wrap things up, especially in regards to Mexico. Most of the industry is considered to be mostly done contracting for 2010. Pricing and offering levels for 2010 contracts on all fat contents have been reported to be between levels considered normal for the past few years and those of the record 2009 season. Export and domestic demand was light to moderate as the Thanksgiving holiday quickly approaches. Schedules were seasonally normal with many reducing schedules for next week and taking the time to do some maintenance between now and the new year. Frame values were steady ranging 6-9 cents FOB, mostly 7-8 cents FOB.

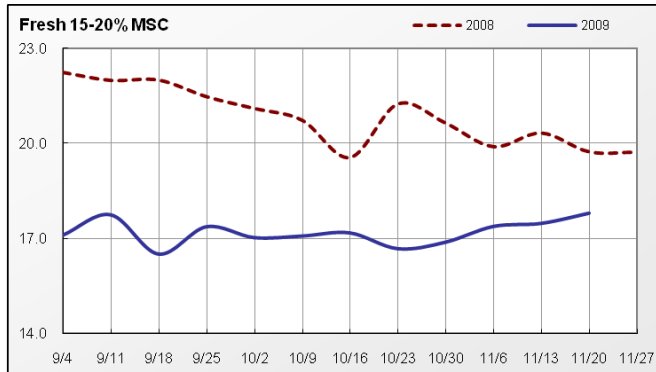

The market tone on tom full-cut wings was steady to firm, tom V-wings and necks steady to barely steady, balance of parts steady to fully steady. Demand ranged slow to good while offerings were light to adequate. The trade sentiment on thigh meat was in a full range, steady to firm. Demand was good with most inquiry into export channels. Offerings were currently inadequate. The market tone on mechanically separated turkey was steady to barely steady. Demand was light with offerings adequate to fully adequate. Domestic: frozen tom breast meat (over 6 mos. age) 129, 20-22 lb. plant grade basted breasts 109, tom gizzards(machine cut)90, tails 29, fresh tom full-cut wings 71-72, fresh necks 36, fresh tails 28 cents delivered. Export: frozen tom breast meat 145-148, tom gizzards (hand cut) 102, fries 140, fresh thigh meat 104 cents delivered port or border.
